



## Annex No. 1: Information clause pursuant to Article 13 of the GDPR

used by the contracting authority for purposes related to the contract award procedure.

In accordance with Article 13 paragraphs 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU L 119, 4.05.2016, p. 1), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", I inform you that:

- the administrator of personal data is Flexon SC Michał Pabiasz Monika Pabiasz , ul. Wiejska 48 42-700 Jawornica
- personal data will be processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR for the purpose of the procurement procedure 1/FENG.03.01-IP.03-1359/25, while maintaining competitiveness,
- the recipients of personal data will be persons or entities to whom the documentation of the proceedings will be made available on the basis of the Project Co-financing Agreement under the European Funds for Modern Economy Programme 2021-2027 and subchapter 3.2 of the Guidelines on the eligibility of expenditure for 2021-2027, hereinafter referred to as "Guidelines";
- personal data will be stored, in accordance with the Agreement on co-financing the Project under the European Funds for Opole 2021-2017, for 10 years from the date of its granting;
- the obligation for a natural person to provide personal data that directly concerns them is a requirement specified in the provisions of the guidelines related to participation in the procurement procedure; the consequences of failure to provide certain data result from the guidelines;
- in relation to personal data, decisions will not be made in an automated manner, in accordance with Article 22 of the GDPR;
- a natural person has:
  - under Article 15 of the GDPR, the right to access personal data concerning him/her;
  - under Article 16 of the GDPR, the right to rectification of your personal data (the right to restrict processing does not apply to storage, to ensure the exercise of legal remedies or to protect the rights of another natural or legal person, or for important reasons of public interest of the European Union or a Member State);
  - under Article 18 of the GDPR, the right to request the controller to restrict the processing of personal data, subject to the cases referred to in Article 18(2) of the GDPR ( *the right to restrict processing* does not apply to storage, to ensure the exercise of legal remedies or to protect the rights of another natural or legal person, or for important reasons of public interest of the European Union or a Member State ) ;
  - the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if an individual considers that the processing of personal data concerning them violates the provisions of the GDPR;
- a natural person is not entitled to:
  - in connection with Article 17(3)(b), (d) or (e) of the GDPR, the right to have personal data deleted;
  - the right to transfer personal data, referred to in Article 20 of the GDPR;
  - under Article 21 of the GDPR, the right to object to the processing of personal data, as the legal basis for the processing of personal data is Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR.
