Official Notification of Stand Assignment and Confirmation of the Exhibit Area

With reference to your participation request for Progetto Fuoco 2026, we are glad to inform you that - as per General Regulations - you have been assigned an exhibit area of:

54 sqm with 2 open sides in Padiglione/Hall 4, stand no. C21 (see the enclosed floor plans for further details)

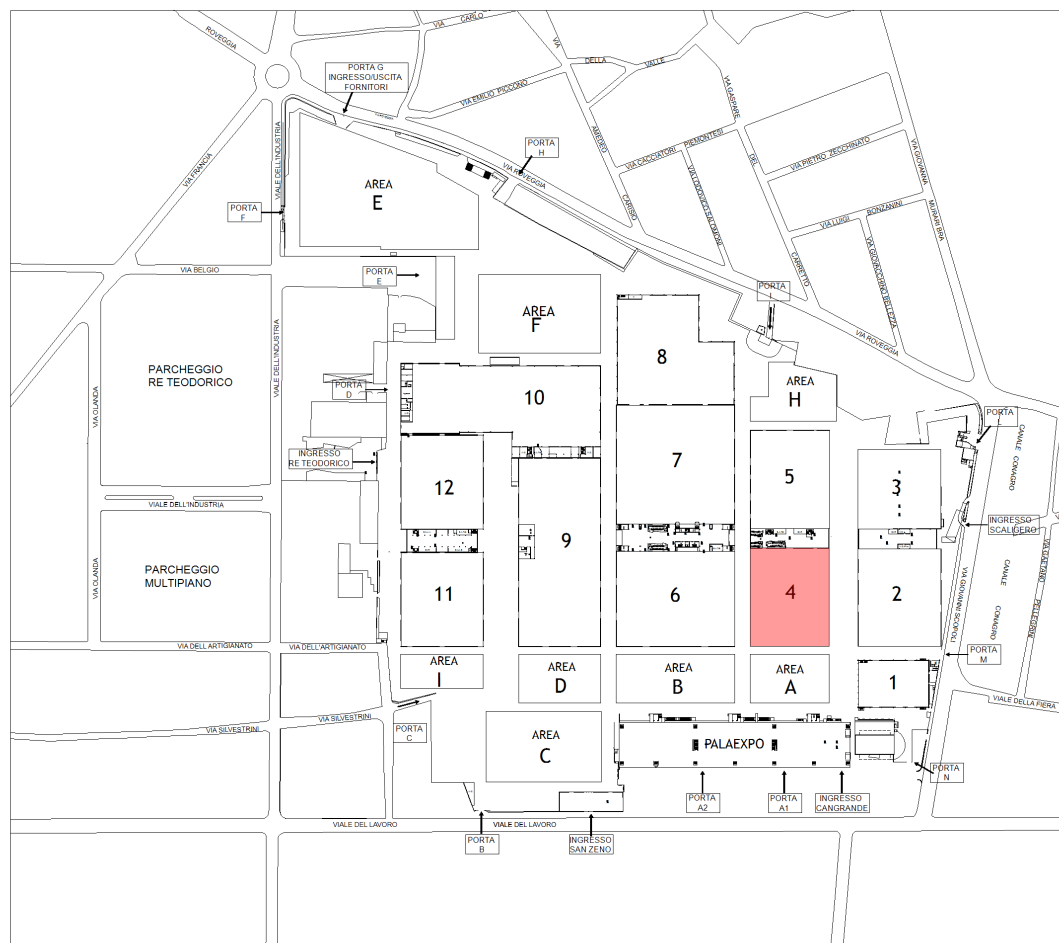
- **Kindly note that the space is NOT FITTED/EQUIPPED** (there aren't partition walls, carpet, electrical system/panel or furniture).
- **4 metres** is the maximum height allowed for stand walls.
- **Open sides of the stand** may be closed with continuous walls or other elements (panels, flower boxes, etc.) for a maximum of 50% of the length of each side.
- **If you have "space only" inside the halls** and no Veronafiere shell scheme stand is in use in the booth, you have to provide decoration and erect partitions/walls between your own and adjoining spaces.
- **Each wall or portion of wall visible** from common areas, aisles or adjacent stands must ensure a perfectly even finish, with a uniform and neutral colour.
- **In the exhibition area fees**, the basic electric package is already included (2 kW each 16 sqm and n. 1 electrical connection).
- Veronafiere can provide turn-key and/or customised stands to exhibitors, on request. For the supply of turn-key stands, additional and compulsory services, we invite you to consult the **E-commerce section**, in your Exhibitors Area.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The balance invoice for the exhibiting area will be available for download directly from the **invoices section** in your Reserved Area (deadline to settle the balance invoice: 19 January 2026). **Particular Wording on invoices** will have to be communicated in advance at the email address lenci@veronafiere.it. The object of the email will have to be: WORDING INVOICE PROGETTO FUOCO 2026.
Your particular wording will have to be indicated also in the reason of the bank transfer.

The exhibitor pass and parking passes will be available in the Reserved Area starting from the end of January, after payment of the balance of participation.

SPACE-ONLY AREAS: the set-up of the booth have to follow this time table:

- *from 19 to 22 February: 7:00 – 20:30 with the possibility of hourly extensions*
- *on the 23 February: 7:00 – 18:00 (end of set-up period) with no possibility of hourly extensions*
- *on the 24 February 07:00 - 16:00 access permitted only to Exhibitors for final stand finishing and product display.*

PRE-FITTED SET-UP: the set-up of the booth have to follow this time table:

- *On the 23 February: 7:00 – 20:30 with no possibility of hourly extensions*
- *On the 24 February 07:00 - 16:00 access permitted only to Exhibitors for final stand finishing and product display.*
- *The pieces of furniture will be placed in the booth from Tuesday 24 February.*

On 24 February 2026 therefore, stand installation, construction and/or material handling operations will not be permitted and access will be denied to all stand contractor/fitters companies.
Goods unloading and positioning operations must be completed by and no later than 6:00 pm on 23 February. After this deadline the official agent for material handling will accept no late request.

DISMANTLING STAGE unless otherwise defined, all exhibit areas are made available for stand dismantling operations with the following timetable:

- *1 - 4 March from 7:00 to 20:30.*

For every day that assets, goods or structures remain in the Exhibition Centre beyond the term defined for disassembly and clearance of stands, Exhibitors will be charged a sum of € 1,000.00 by way of penalty, as well as other compensation of eventual damages in excess of this sum.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT DURING STAND BUILD-UP AND DISMANTLING

In accordance with consolidated Health and Safety at Work Regulations (ref.: Legislative Decree D.Lgs. 81/2008) and Veronafiere Technical Regulations, throughout the installation and dismantling periods all exhibitors, stand contractor companies and their employees inside the Exhibition Centre must wear **appropriate P.P.E. Personal Protective Equipment** to ensure safe working conditions: safety shoes, high-visibility jackets, etc... Workers who do not have appropriate PPE will not be allowed to continue stand installation and fitting work until the safety measures required by law have been complied with.

During stand installation and dismantling stages all personnel must present at the access doors the "Installation/Dismantling Pass" for individuals and vehicles that can be printed from the Access Control Portal and be equipped with an individual ID badge of the company to which they belong pursuant to Legislative Decree 81/08 and subsequent amendments and additions.

COMPULSORY CUSTOMS PROCEDURES

According to Art. 250(2)(b) and (d) of the UNHRC and Art. 323 of the Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 2015/24474, and by Art. 197 et seq. of the UNHRC and Art. 197(1) of the TULD, for materials from non-EU countries, which are brought into the country under the "temporary admission" procedure, arrangements must be made for their return by confirming the terms of the legal procedure.
