Announcement of intention to award a contract

Case reference: DZP.26.3.2026

To Article 11 ust. 5 pkt 1 the Act of 11 September 2019 – Public Procurement Law (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2024, point 1320, as amended), the Łukasiewicz Research Network - Institute of Aviation in Warsaw, informs about intention to award a contract, concerning **the supply of multi-channel measurement system for strain gauge, temperature and other signals.**

The subject of the contract is intended solely for research, experimental, scientific, or development purposes that do not serve the purpose of mass production by the Ordering Party aimed at achieving market profitability or covering research or development costs.

The value of the order is less than the EU thresholds.

§ 2. The description of the subject matter of the contract

1. The subject matter of the contract is the delivery of a multi-channel measurement system for strain gauge, temperature and other signals for the Łukasiewicz Research Network – Institute of Aviation (hereinafter referred to as "Ł-ILOT").
A detailed description of the subject matter of the contract is provided in:
Appendix no. 1 to the Announcement - Description of Subject Matter of the Contract (hereinafter referred to as "DSO").
2. If any indication of origin (brand, trademark, manufacturer, or supplier) appears in the description of the subject matter of the contract, it is to be understood as a reference to the required standard and technical characteristics. The Contracting Authority permits the offering of equivalent materials, provided they achieve technical parameters that are no less favourable than those specified, i.e., they must meet or exceed the technical, functional, and quality requirements defined in the aforementioned document.
3. If the description of the subject matter of the contract refers to Polish Standards, it is acceptable to apply equivalent standards from European Union member states, insofar as they are recognised under Polish legislation, provided that such standards ensure performance that is no less stringent than the specified Polish Standards.
4. If the above provisions require clarification, a request for clarification should be submitted via the electronic platform available at: <https://ilot.eb2b.com.pl> (in the manner specified in § 8(11) of the Announcement).
5. The Contractor shall also be excluded from the procedure if any of the grounds specified in Article 7 of the Act of 13 April 2022 on special measures to prevent support for aggression against Ukraine and to protect national security apply.

The tender of a contractor excluded from the proceedings shall be deemed rejected.

§ 3. Contract Completion Date

The Contractor shall be required to complete the entire subject matter of the contract within 25 weeks from the date of submit the order.

§ 5. Possibility of cooperation with Contracting Authority

1. If another Contractor is able to offer a product that meets the minimum requirements of the Ordering Party specified in this Announcement, please send information about this together with your offer **by 10:00 a.m. on February 3, 2026**, send information about this together with the offer. The offer containing documentation confirming that the offered product meets all the Ordering Party's requirements should be submitted in the manner specified in § 7.
2. If the documentation attached to the offer does not clearly indicate that the offered solution meets the minimum requirements of the Ordering Party, the Ordering Party shall consider the Contractor's offer to be inconsistent with this Announcement and subject to rejection.
3. If, by the deadline specified above, the Ordering Party has not received information that another Contractor is able to offer the subject of the contract meeting its minimum requirements and offers, the Ordering Party shall award the contract to the Contractor indicated in § 4.

§ 6. Criteria for Evaluation of Tenders and Selection of the Most Advantageous Tender

If another bid meeting the minimum requirements specified in this Announcement is submitted within the specified time limit, the Contracting Authority shall evaluate tenders on the basis of the following criterion:

Price – weighting: 100%.

Maximum number of points available: 100 points.

Points will be awarded using the following formula:

$$P_{\text{(price)}} = \frac{C_{\text{(min)}}}{C_{\text{(offer)}}} \times 100 \text{ pkt}$$

where:

P price- number of points awarded for the price criterion

C min- the lowest tender price submitted

C offer- the price of the tender under evaluation

Calculations will be carried out to two decimal places, without rounding.

If it is not possible to select the most advantageous tender due to two or more tenders having been submitted at the same price, the Contracting Authority shall invite the Economic Operators who submitted those tenders to submit, within a deadline specified by the Contracting Authority, additional tenders containing a revised price.

The Contracting Authority shall award the contract to the Economic Operator whose tender receives the highest total score in accordance with the evaluation criterion.

§ 7. Description of Tender Preparation and documents required

1. Each Contractor may submit only one offer containing a price. If a tender is submitted in a currency other than PLN, it will be converted at the average exchange rate of the National Bank of Poland (Table A) on the date of the deadline for submission of tenders.
2. The content of the offer must correspond to the content of the Announcement, in particular the description of the subject of the contract.

3. The tender must be drawn up in Polish or English.
4. The Economic Operator shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the tender.
5. The Contractor shall attach to the offer:
 - 1) technical specifications and/or other informational materials confirming the conformity of the offered subject of the contract with the requirements specified in this Announcement;
 - 2) a statement confirm the absence of grounds for exclusion – **Appendix no. 2 to the Announcement.**
6. The tender should be submitted via the electronic platform available at: <https://ilot.eb2b.com.pl>, the one referred in **§ 8**.

§ 8. Description of the method of submitting statements or documents and communicating with Contractors

1. All correspondence between Economic Operators and the Contracting Authority in this procedure shall be conducted electronically. All requests, declarations, and the tender shall be sent via the electronic platform available at: <https://ilot.eb2b.com.pl> ("Platform"); Use of the platform is free of charge.
2. In order to submit an offer, it is required that the Economic Operator must register on the platform. If the Economic Operator already has an account, they may log in using their individual login credentials and password.
3. The Economic Operator accepts and undertakes to comply with the terms and conditions for use of the platform referred to in section 1, as set out in the Terms and Conditions available at <https://ilot.eb2b.com.pl/default/cms/page/id/terms-and-conditions/popup/1>.
4. After completing the registration form, the Economic Operator shall receive an email informing them that they may proceed with their first login to the platform.
5. The minimum technical requirements for using the platform are as follows:
 - 1) permanent access to the Internet with a guaranteed bandwidth of at least 10 Mbps;
 - 2) a PC or MAC computer with the following configuration: min. 4GB Ram, Intel IV 2GHZ processor, and one of the operating systems - MS Windows 7, Mac Os x 10.4, Linux, or their newer versions;
 - 3) any web browser; for Internet Explorer, version 10.0 or later;
 - 4) JavaScript enabled;
 - 5) Acrobat Reader installed.
6. Once logged into the platform, the Economic Operator should select the "Proceedings" tab and then the "Open Proceedings List" tab.
7. After selecting the "Open Proceedings List" tab, the Economic Operator can procedure, for which they wish to obtain information, including access to the annexes.
8. Once the procedure has been selected, the Economic Operator may access basic information about the selected procedure via the Procedure Settings tab.
9. Click on the Annexes tab to view the documents relating to the subject matter of the procedure. The Economic Operator may download individual annexes by clicking on the document and selecting Download, or download all annexes simultaneously by selecting the Download package command and then Download all organiser's annexes;
10. Notify their intention to participate in the procedure by clicking on Submit to Proceedings — this is also possible only after registration and login. Registration for participation is necessary to perform the activities referred to in paragraphs 15 and 16.
11. The Economic Operator submit a question to the Contracting Authority by clicking on Questions/Information — this option becomes available after registration and login to the platform and submit to proceedings;
12. The submission of a tender with annexes is carried out by uploading the price quote and required electronic documents (annexes), referred to **§ 7 (5)**, via the Annexes tab. The Economic

Operator shall select Add Annex and choose the file to be uploaded; the submission of a tender - this option becomes available after registration and login to the platform and submit to proceedings.

13. The Economic Operator should name each uploaded document in a way that allows it to be clearly identified without the need for the Contracting Authority to open it.
14. If the Economic Operator wishes to designate any content within a document as a trade secret, within the meaning of the Act of 16 April 1993 on Combating Unfair Competition, the relevant annex must be clearly marked as containing a trade secret. The contracting authority recommends that information constituting a trade secret be attached in a separate file.
15. The annex is added by clicking Save.
16. Confirmation that the document has been successfully uploaded is provided by the system message: "File has been loaded."
17. If the Economic Operator uploads an incorrect file or determines that an uploaded document requires correction, they may remove it at any time prior to the deadline for submission of tenders by selecting the file and clicking Remove.
18. The offer is prepared in one of the data formats specified in the regulations issued pursuant of the Act of 17 February 2005 on the Computerisation of Activities of Entities Performing Public Tasks.
19. The time of receipt by the platform shall be indicated by the date and exact time (hh:mm:ss) assigned to the electronic document, visible in the Date of Transmission column on the left-hand side.

§ 9. Other provisions

1. No appeal may be lodged against the outcome of this procedure (selection of a tender, rejection of a tender, cancellation of the procedure).
2. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to terminate the procedure without selecting any of the bids, to cancel the procedure or to invalidate it in whole or in part without giving any reason.
3. Settlement will be made in PLN, with the proviso that the Contracting Authority must give its consent to settlement in another currency.

§ 10. Information regarding the processing of personal data

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), OJ L 119, 04.05.2016, p. 1 (hereinafter: "GDPR"), the Contracting Authority hereby informs that:

- 2) personal data will be processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR, for purposes related to the announcement of intention to award a contract entitled: "Supply of a multi-channel measurement system for strain gauge, temperature and other signals" (case reference: DZP.26.3.2026);
- 3) the recipients of personal data will be persons or entities supervising, controlling, and coordinating the activities of the Łukasiewicz Research Network – Institute of Aviation, as well as persons or entities to whom the documentation of the proceedings will be made available

in accordance with the provisions of the Act of September 6, 2001, on access to public information;

- 4) personal data will be stored only for the period required for document archiving, i.e. 5 years;
- 5) providing personal data directly is voluntary, but it is a condition for participation in the above-mentioned proceedings.
- 6) no decisions concerning your personal data will be made solely by automated means, and no profiling of personal data will be used;
- 7) the person to whom the personal data relates has:
 - a) the right of access, pursuant to Article 15 of the GDPR, to the personal data concerning you;
 - b) the right to rectification, pursuant to Article 16 of the GDPR;
 - c) the right to request restriction of processing, pursuant to Article 18 of the GDPR, except in the cases specified in Article 18(2) of the GDPR;
 - d) the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (UODO), if you believe that the processing of your personal data is in breach of the GDPR.
- 8) the data subject shall not have the right to:
 - a) the right to erasure of personal data (the "right to be forgotten"), pursuant to Article 17(3)(b), (d), and (e) of the GDPR;
 - b) the right to data portability, as referred to in Article 20 of the GDPR;
 - c) the right to object to the processing of your personal data under Article 21 of the GDPR, as the legal basis for processing is Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR.

Economic Operator applying to participate in the procedure should fulfilled the information obligations p set out in Articles 13 or 14 of the GDPR towards all natural persons from whom I have directly or indirectly obtained personal data in connection with participation in this procurement procedure.
